

## PREPARATION CHECKLIST FOR INITIAL PEST CONTROL SERVICE FOR FLEAS

Prior to the initial service, the following steps should be performed by the homeowner, to enable the technician to perform the most thorough treatment possible.

- 1. If a pet is still present, the pet must be treated by your veterinarian at the same time the property is being treated.
- 2. Vacuum all floor areas prior to treatment (dispose of used sweeper bag). Stay off of treated surfaces until thoroughly dry (approximately 4 hours). After chemical has dried, normal activities may be resumed. Frequent vacuuming may help.
- 3. Wash all pet bedding prior to treatment.
- 4. Remove all small items from floor areas. The more floor space we can treat, the better results we will have.
- 5. Be active through out the treatment area. Be patient. The different growth stages of the flea need to emerge and come in contact with the insecticide. A follow up treatment should be performed in 30 days.
- 6. All pets (including birds and fish) must be removed from the area to be treated. If fish cannot be removed, air pumps must be disconnected and the tanks sealed with plastic. WE WILL NOT BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SAFETY OF YOUR FISH ANDBIRDS.
